Air Transportation Support Services

Under contract with FEMA, IEM is providing on-demand air charter and logistics services. To support declared or undeclared emergencies, disaster response operations and other national events and incidents within the United States, its territories, and possessions, IEM is prepared to transport responders, personnel, survivors, equipment, and vehicles to and from affected areas.

IEM Air™

IEM Air™ conducts **airfield site assessments and operations** using former U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) flight and aeromedical evacuation aircrews, command and control personnel, aerial port experts, airfield survey team members, Air Mobility Liaison Officers, and Air Mobility Command (AMC) Contingency Response Wing personnel. IEM's assessment teams use a highly modified AMC Form 1174 – Airfield Survey Form that are accepted by FEMA, the U.S. Transportation Command, and AMC to update the Airfield Suitability and Restrictions Report database and to conduct planning.

Airfield assessments include supporting **pre- and post-evacuations, logistics cargo movement, aeromedical evacuations, aerial search and rescue, and disaster responder airlift.**

Post-event assessments are used to reopen airfields in the impact area and to evaluate incident area airports in order to:

- Determine readiness to accept flights;
- Determine requirements for returning to operational status; and
- Provide real-time assessments on airfields by recognized experts.
